1. A Tentative Tract Map with a proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration to allow for the creation of 298 single-family residential lots from four existing undeveloped parcels zoned R-1 Single Family Residential (Tentative Tract Map 20341)

Location: Southwest corner of Eucalyptus Street and the logical extension of Caliente Road.

Recommendation:
