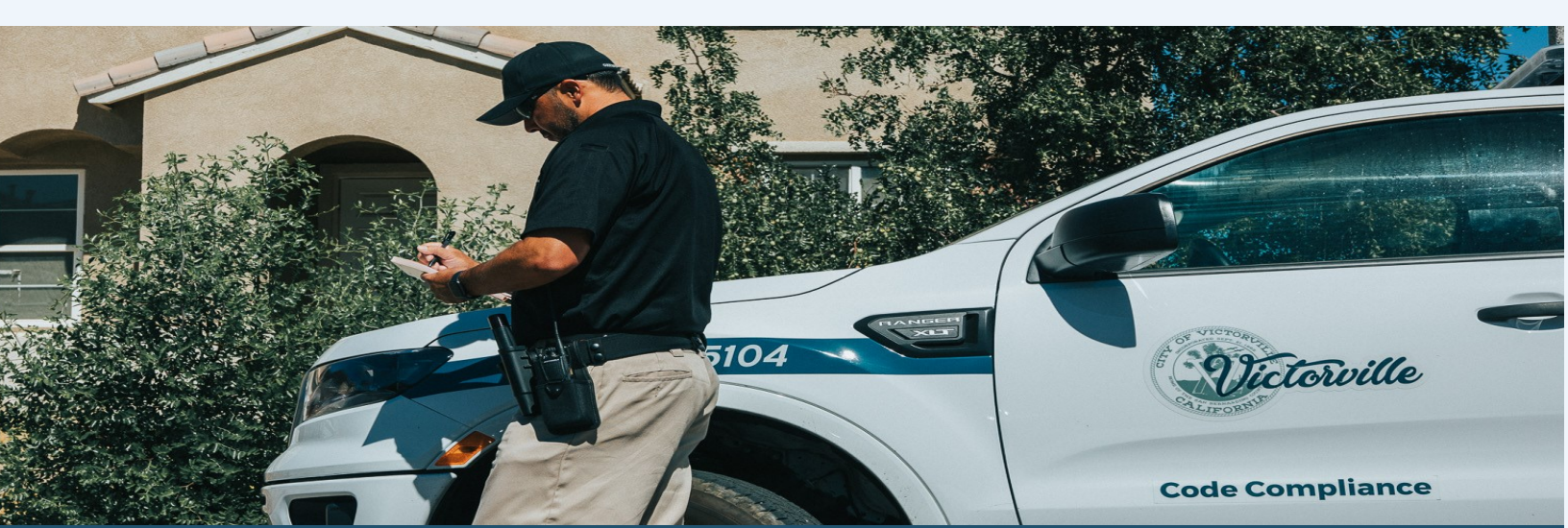


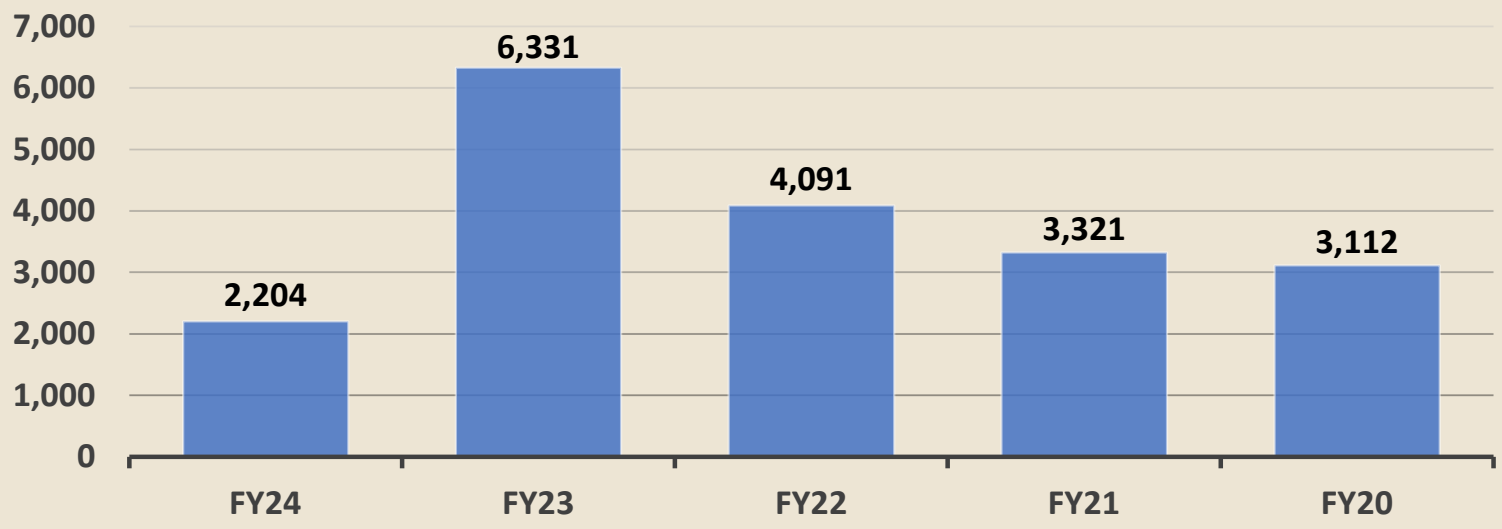

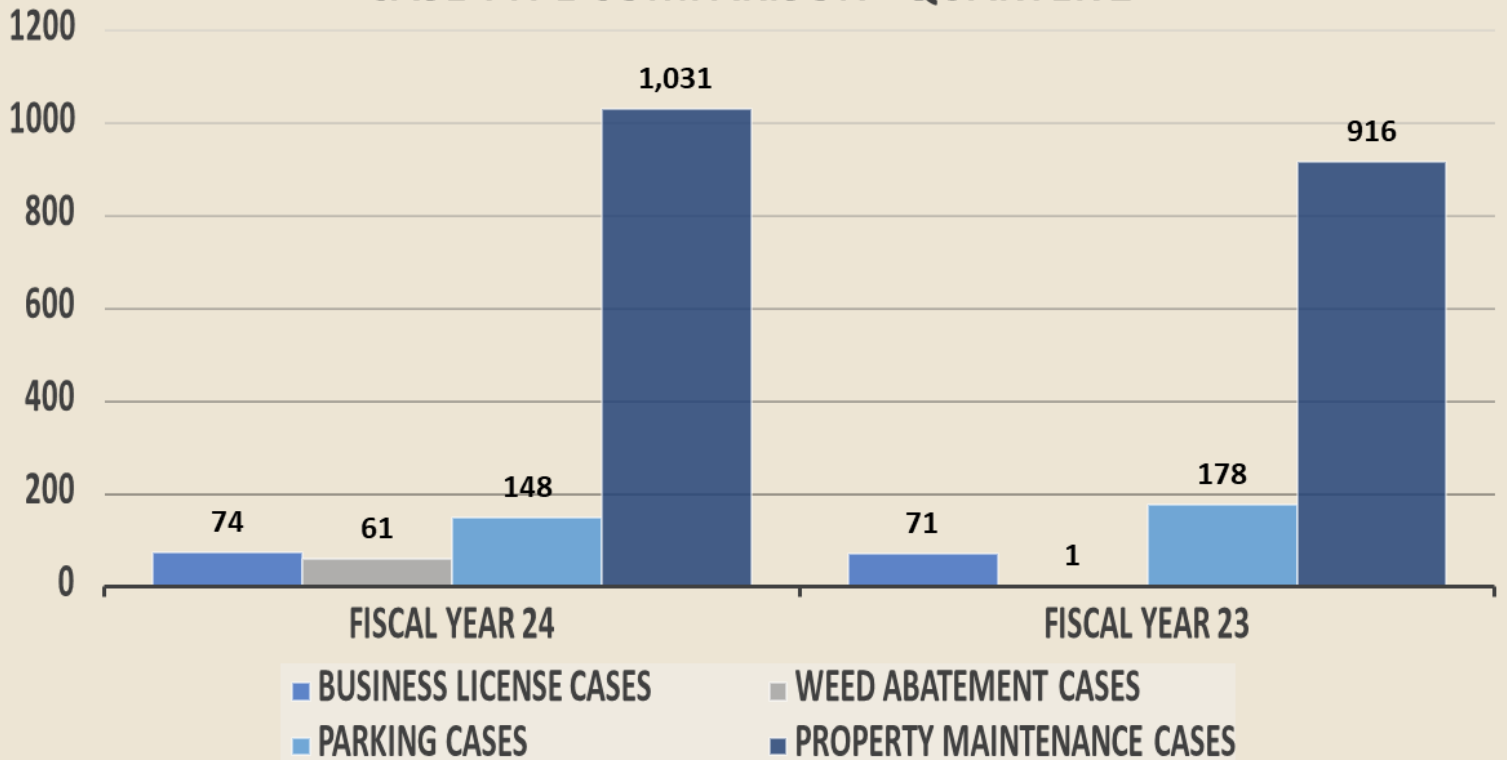
TOTAL CASES PER FISCAL YEAR



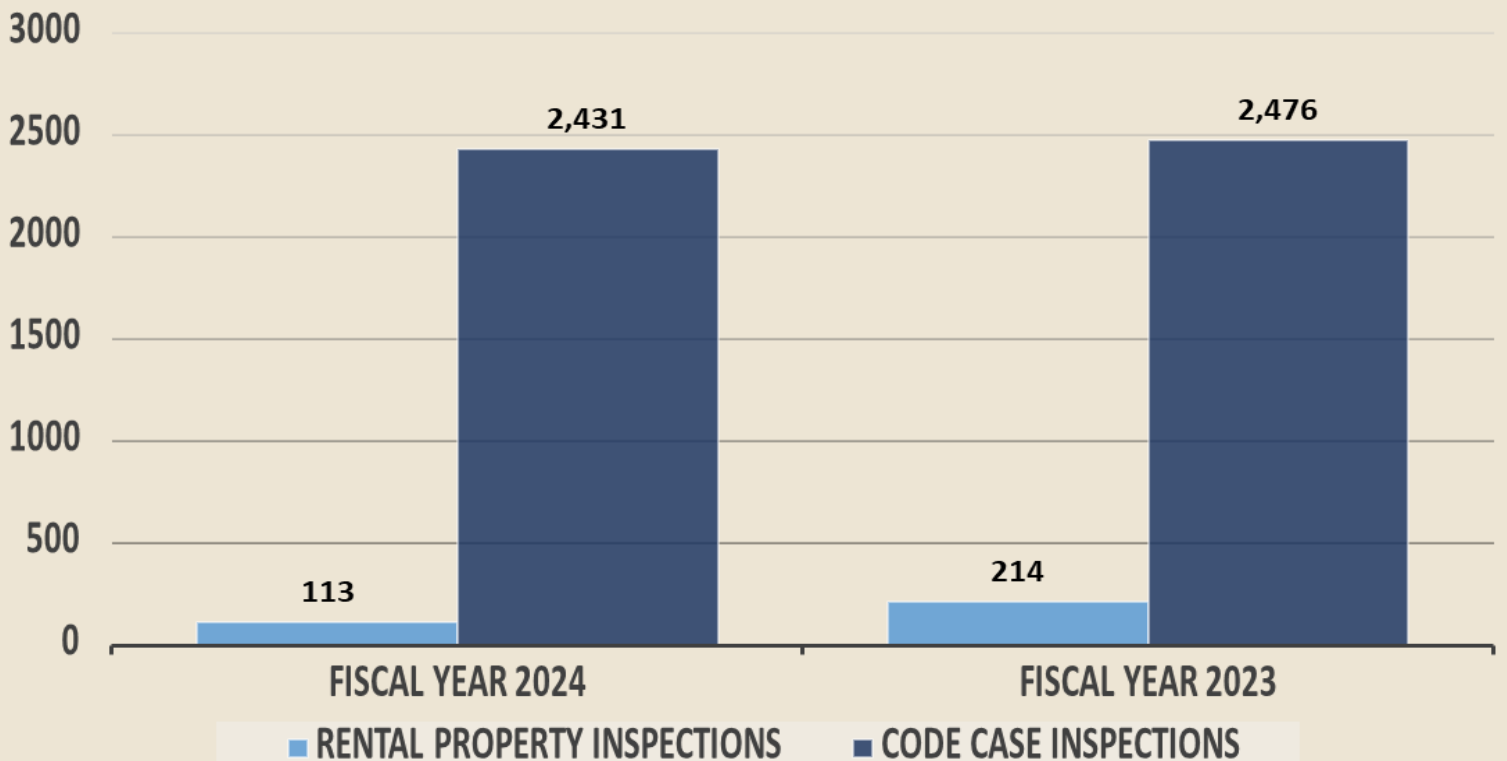

CASE TYPE COMPARISON - QUARTER 2



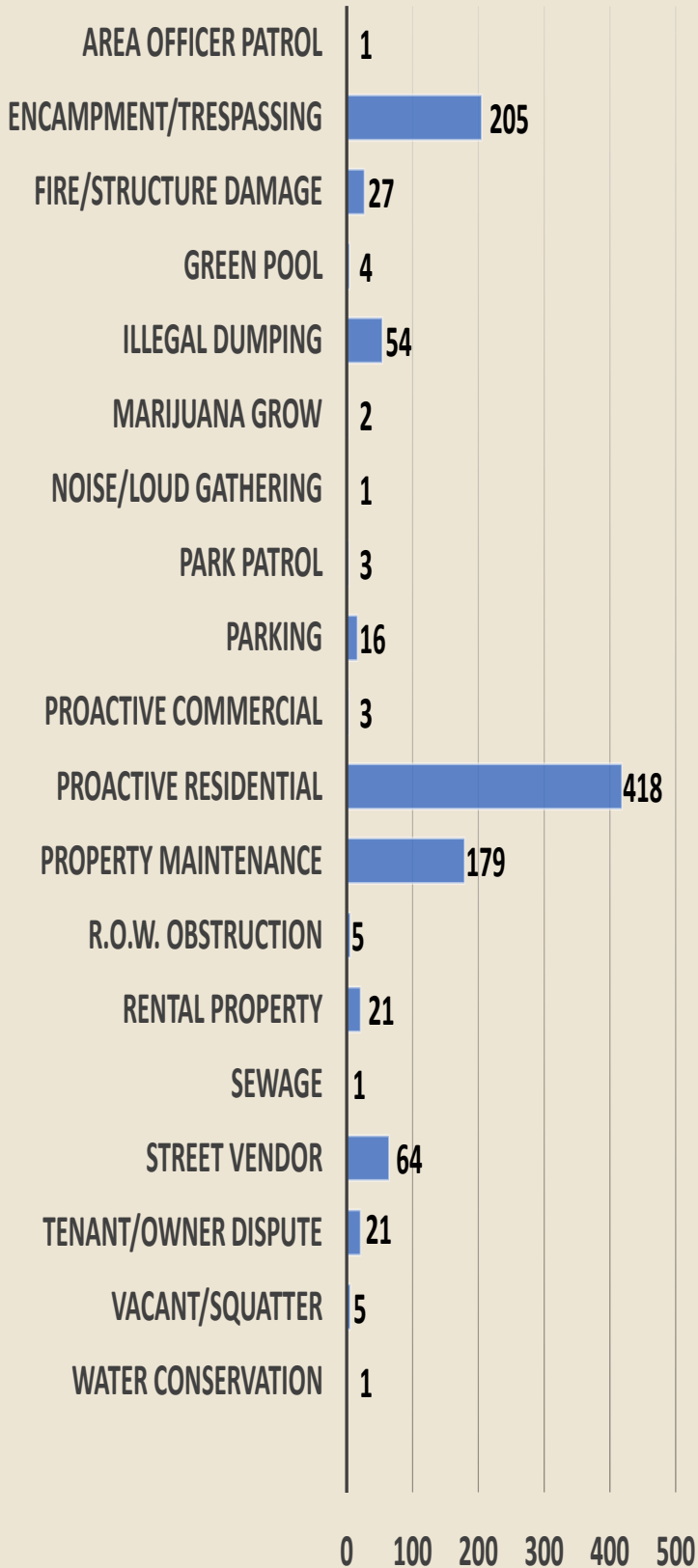
INSPECTION COMPARISON - QUARTER 2



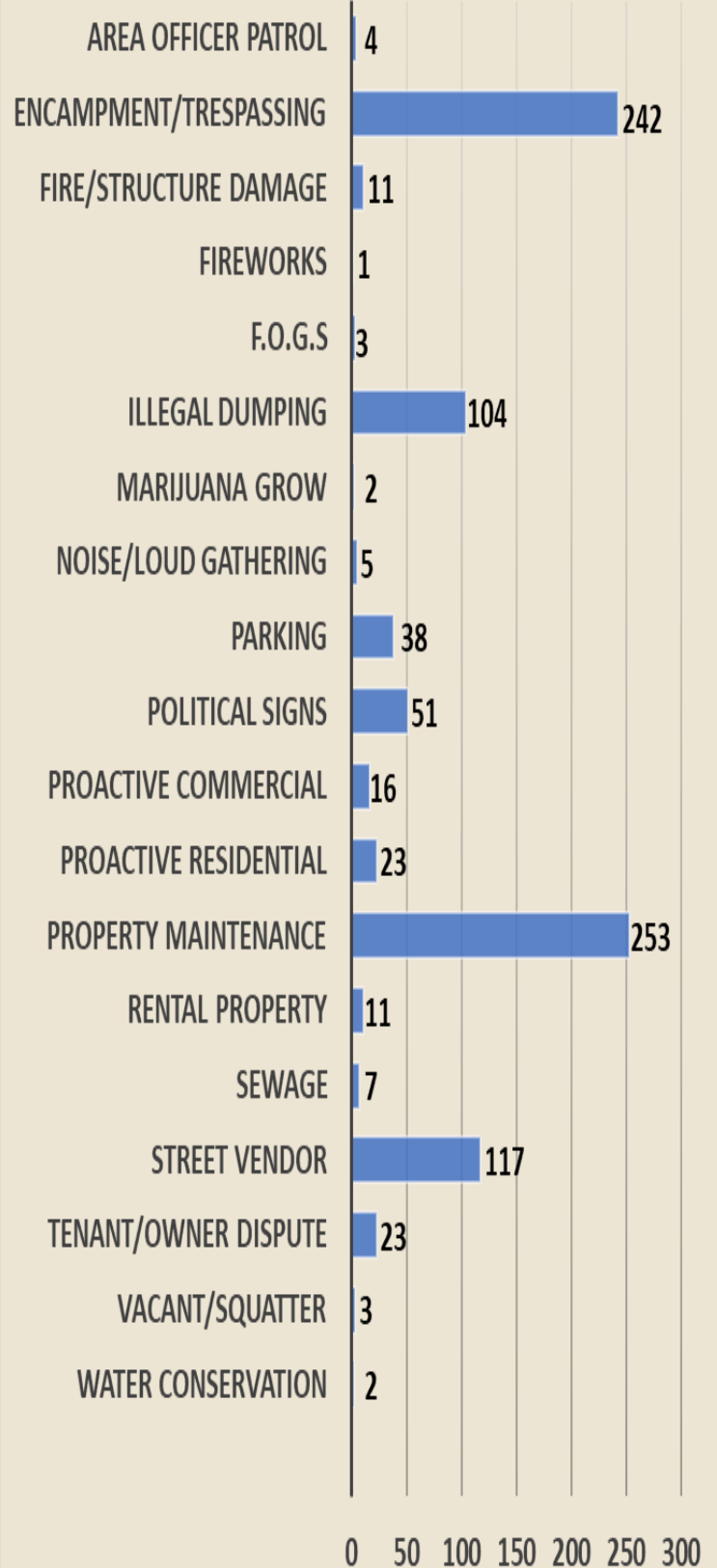
Case Classification Comparison

CASE CLASSIFICATIONS FY24 QRT 2



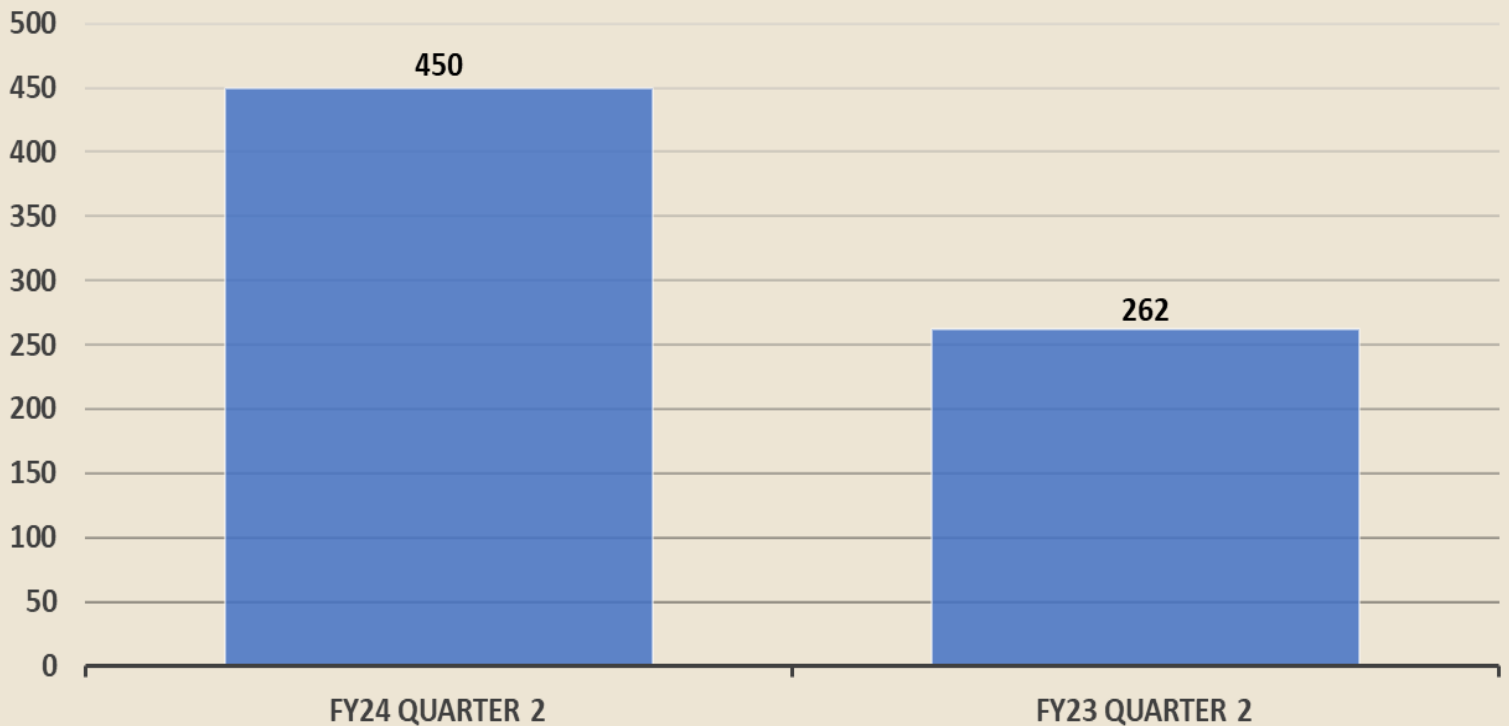
CASE CLASSIFICATIONS FY23 QRT 2



Parking Compliance Comparison

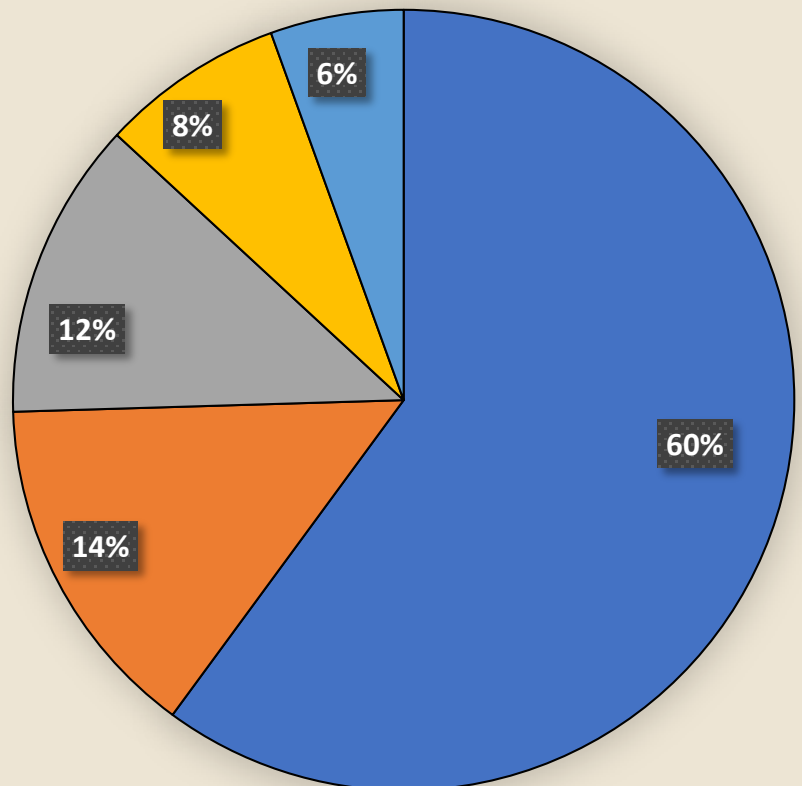

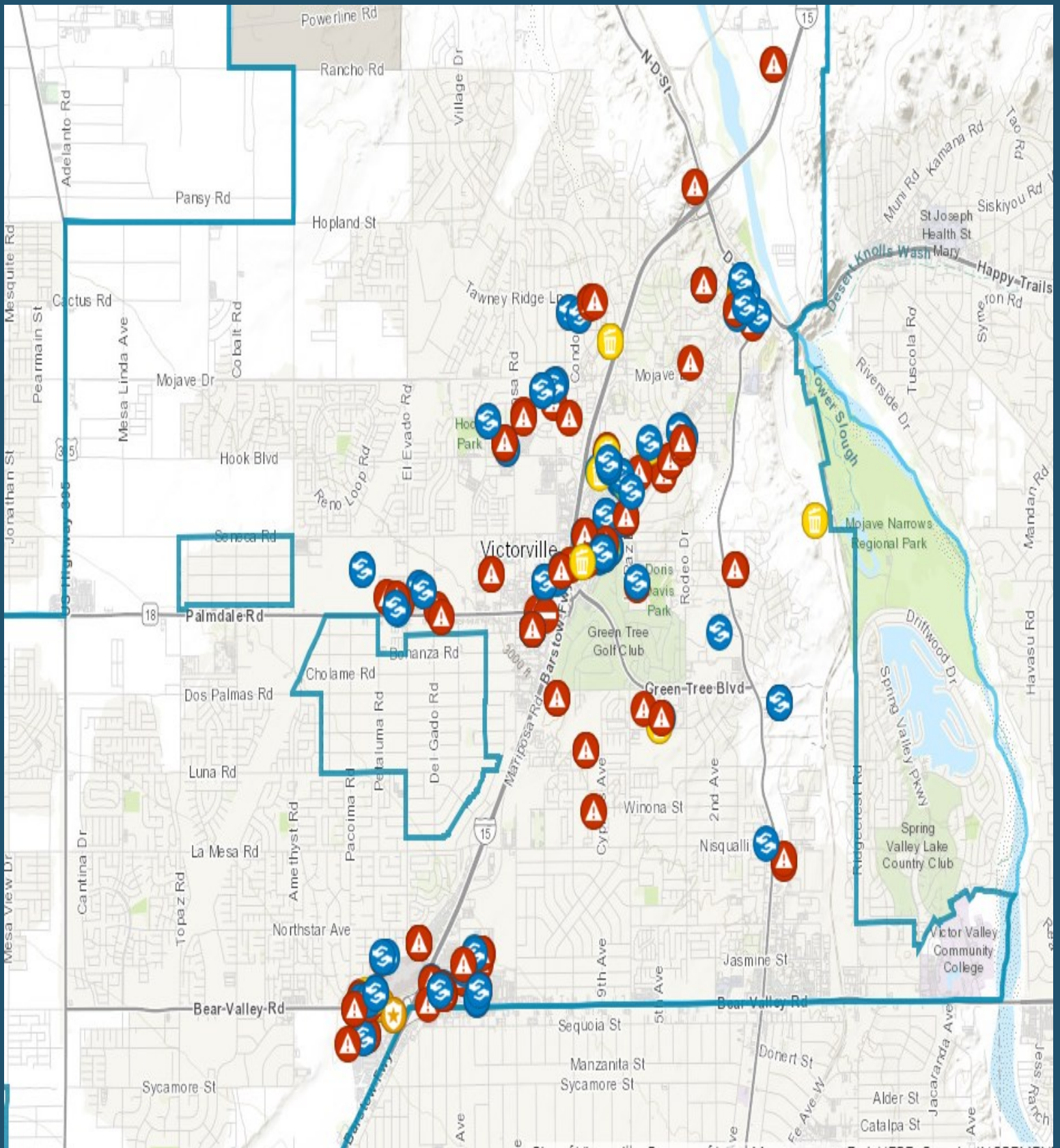

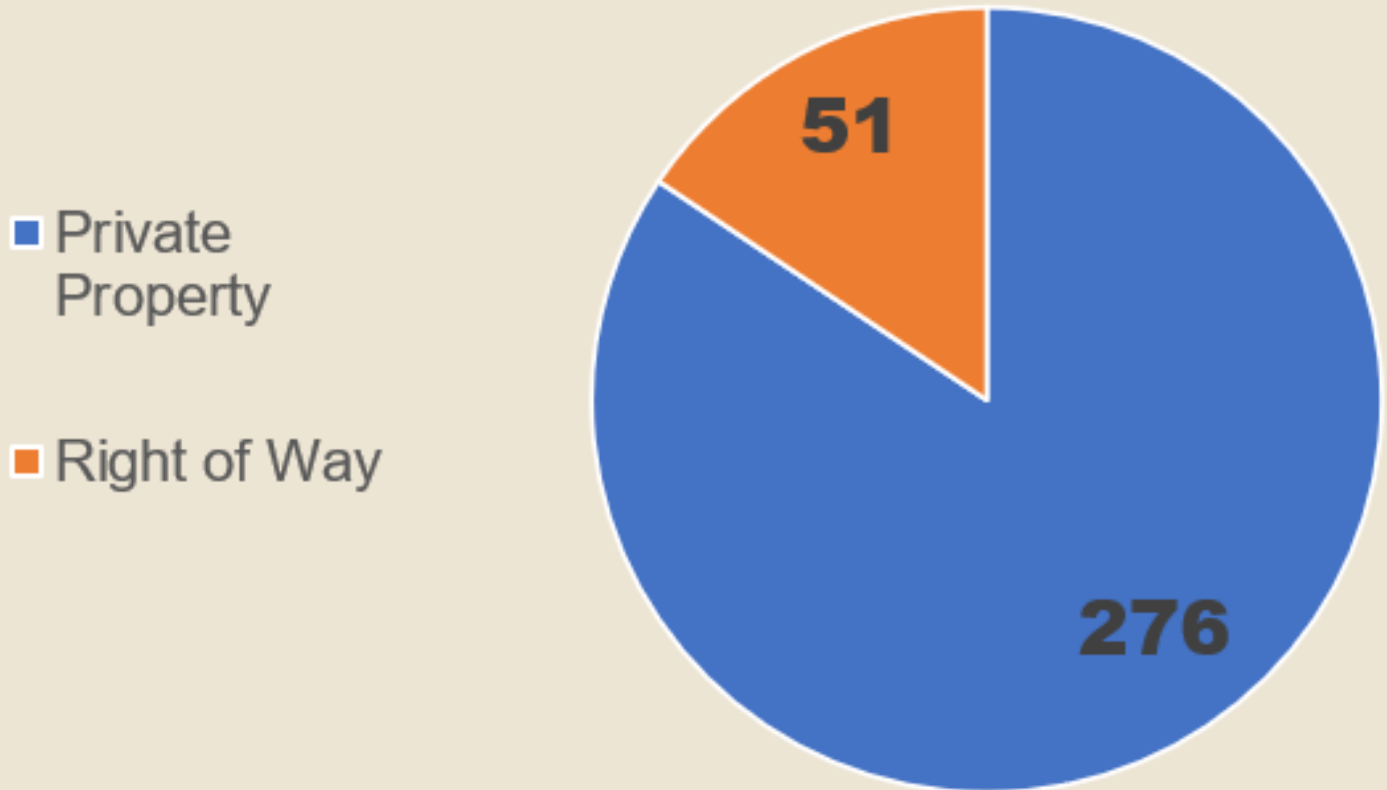

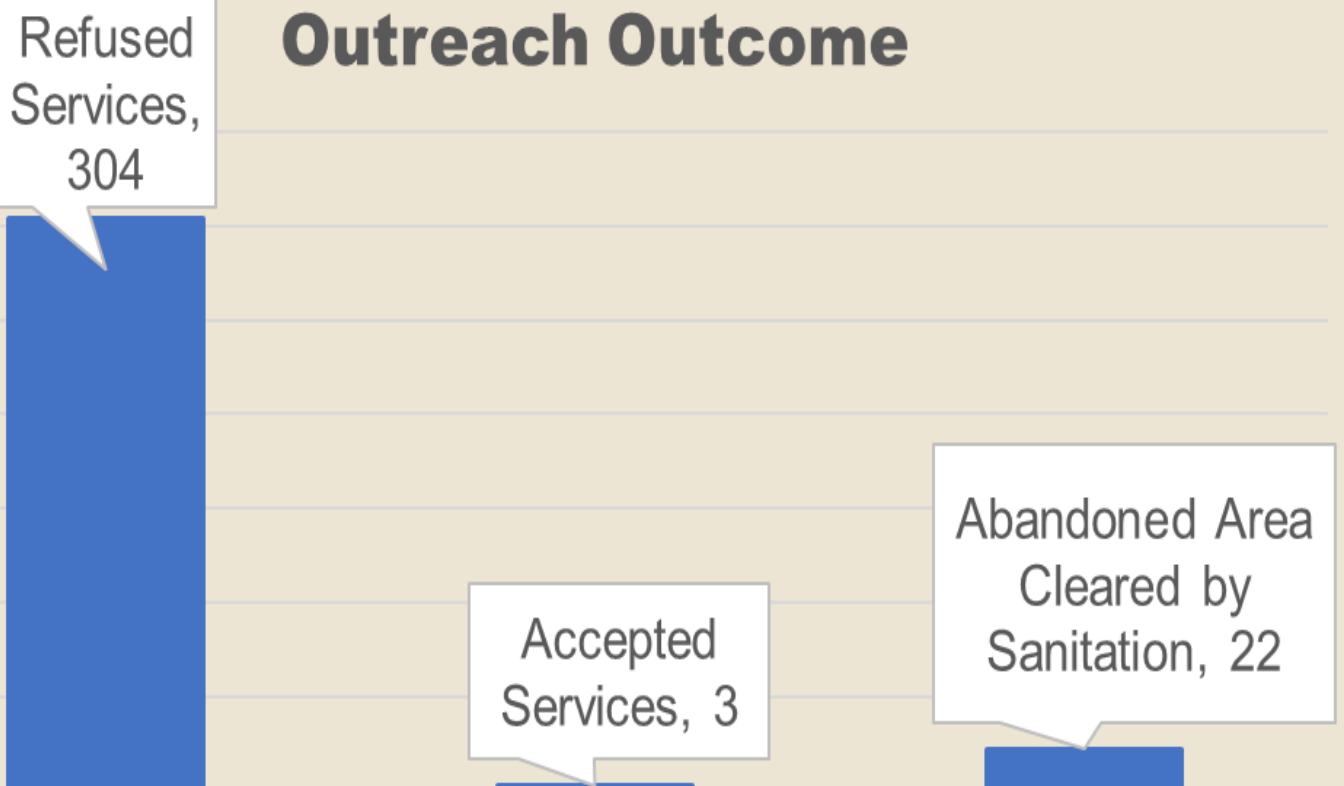

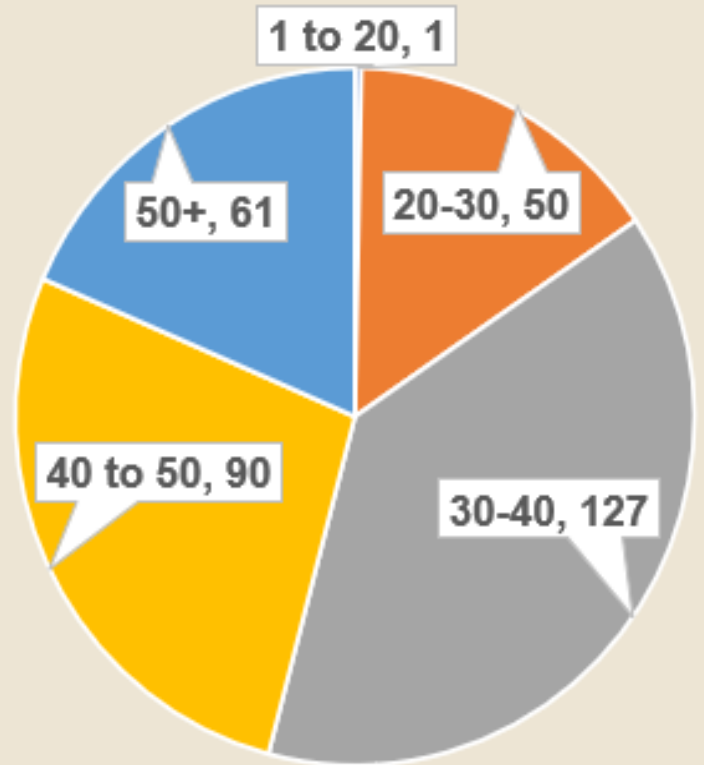
