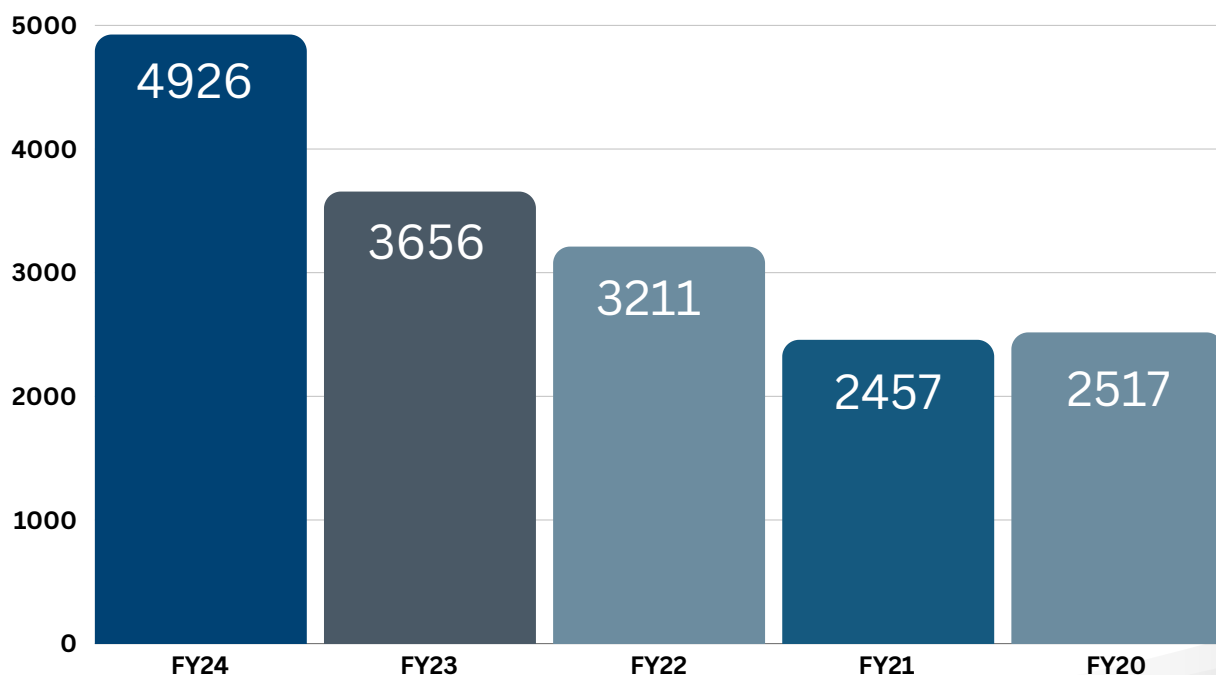

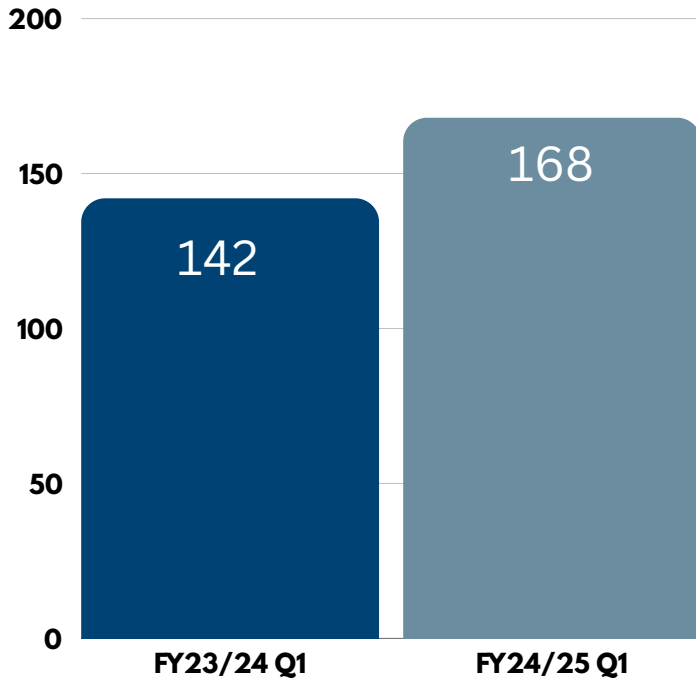

TOTAL CASES PER CALENDAR YEAR

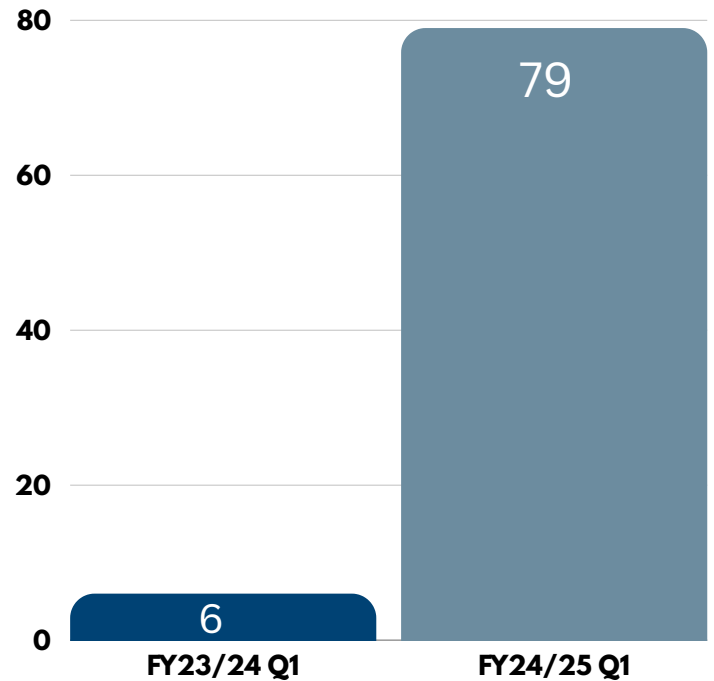


CASE TYPE COMPARISON FY 24/25 QUARTER 1

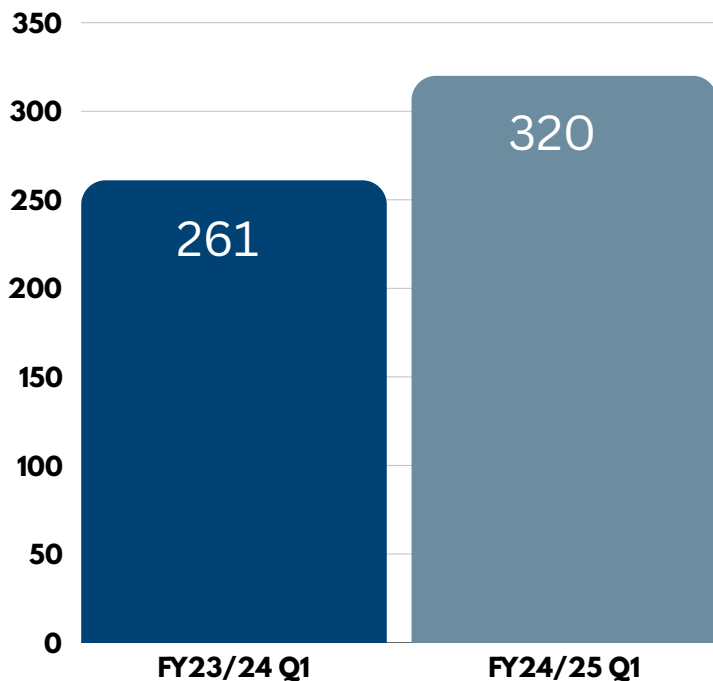

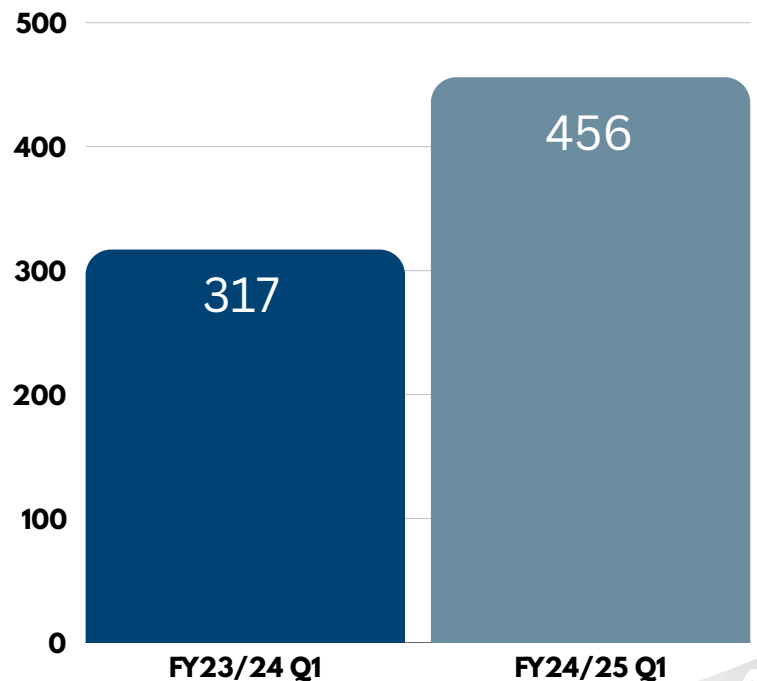

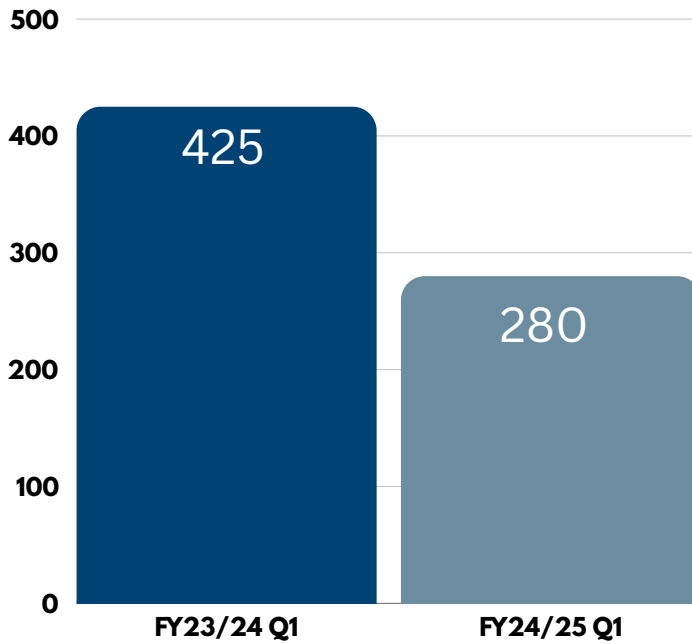

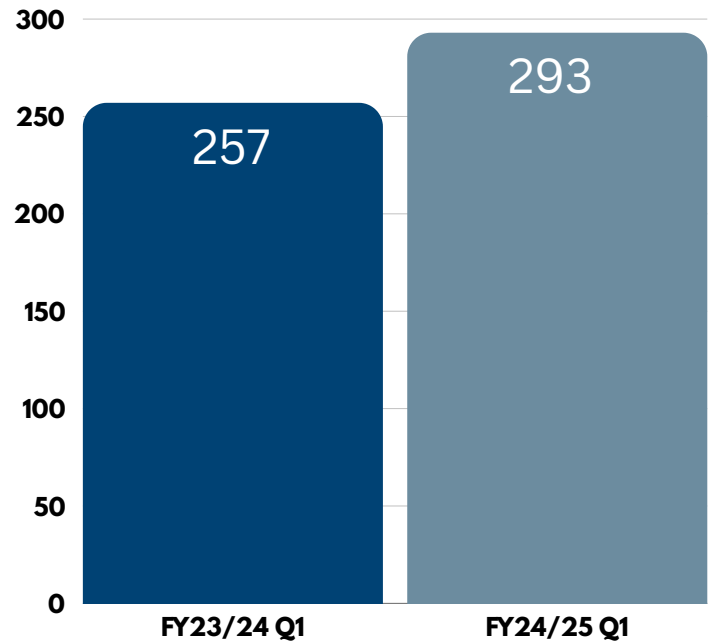


CASE TYPE COMPARISON CONTINUED FY 24/25 QUARTER 1

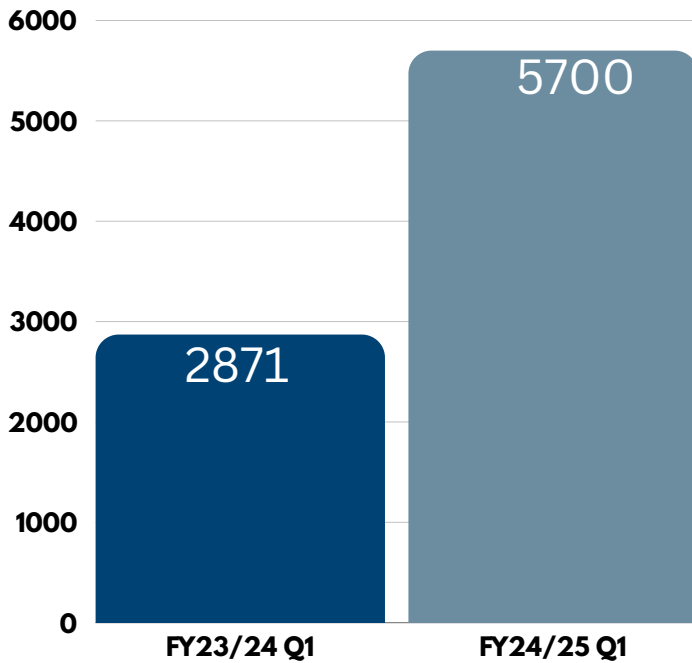

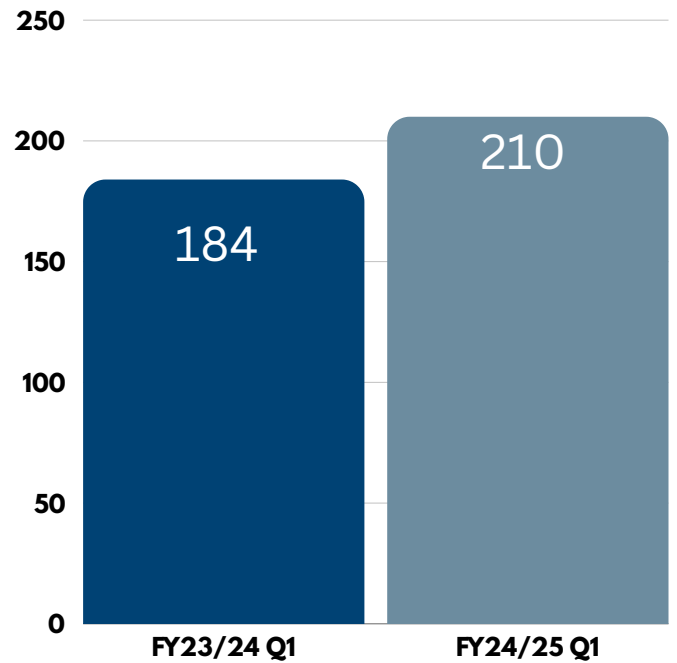


COMPLETED INSPECTIONS COMPARISON FY24/25 Q1

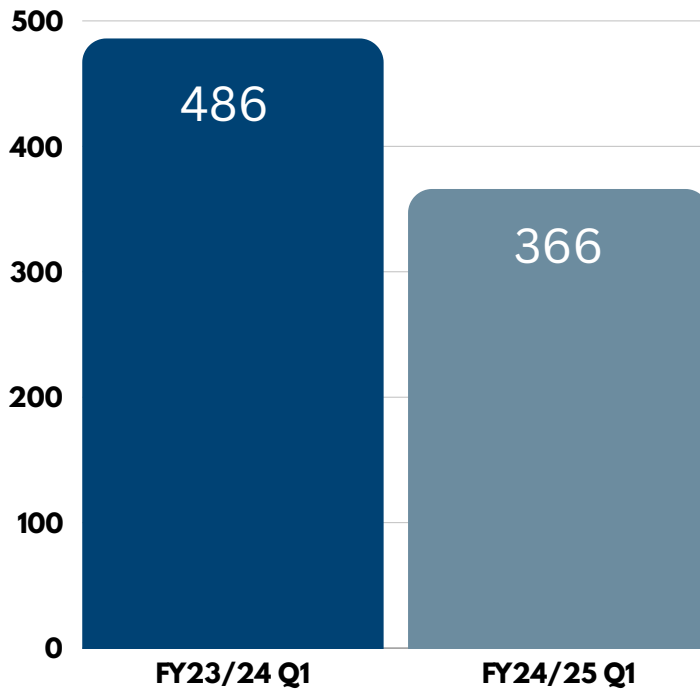

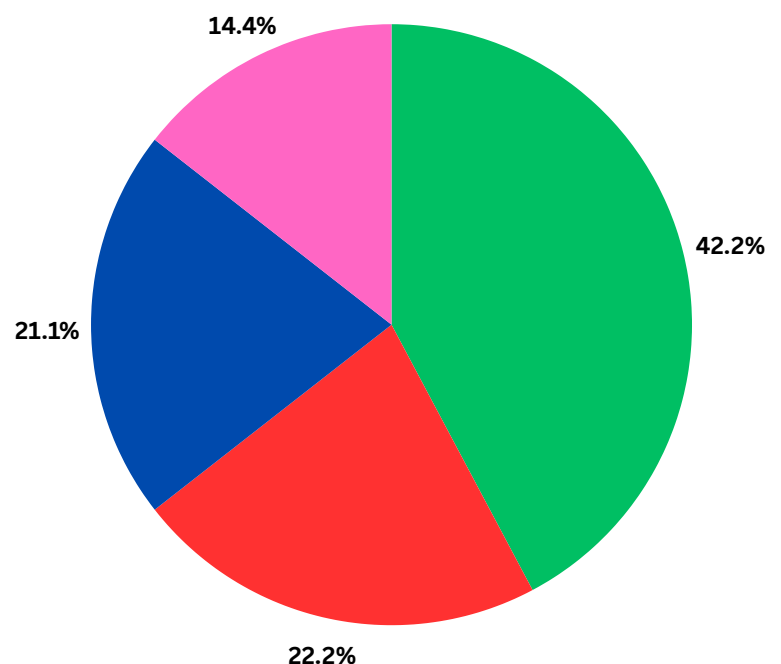

HOMELESS ENGAGEMENT

HOMELESS ENGAGEMENT 07/01/2024 - 09/30/2024 (Q1 FY24/25)

- 172 people accepted shelter referrals from the homeless outreach teams.
- 216 camp areas were cleared during this quarter.

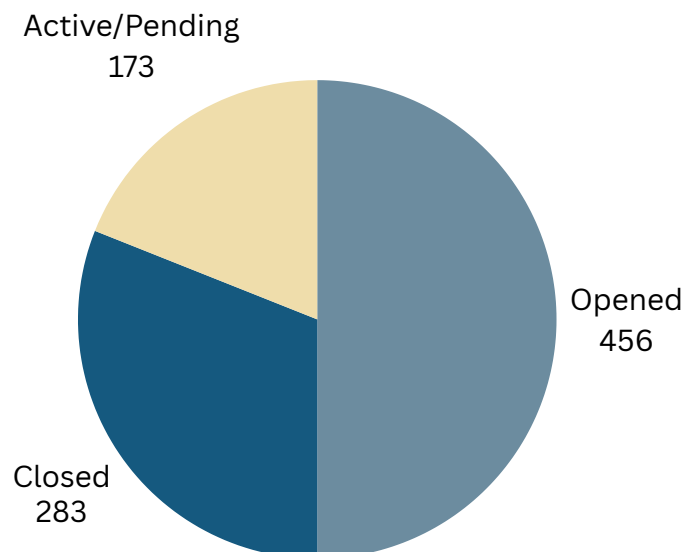
DUNIA PLAZA

The City's Police Department, Code Enforcement, Animal Control and Sanitation teams have increased efforts to enforce growing issues such as pan handling, loitering, littering, and shopping cart theft, in commercial centers. The City teams have worked jointly with property and business owners of commercial centers to deter such activities, and we have seen great improvements in many areas, such as the Dunia Plaza location.



HOMELESS ENGAGEMENT CASES STATS

During Quarter 1 of FY 24/25, a total of 456 cases were opened regarding homeless encampments and a total of 285 of those cases have been resolved. There are currently 173 encampment cases pending either abatement by the owner or pending 602 trespass agreements with the City. 602 trespass agreements submitted by property/business owners authorize the City teams to abate encampments that are on private property.



FY 24/25 Q1 HIGHLIGHTS

CLOSURE OF ILLICIT BUSINESS

Collaborative efforts between the City of Victorville's Code Enforcement Department and the Police Department have resulted in the revocation of a local barbershop's business license. The investigation revealed that the establishment was engaged in illicit drug activity, prompting swift action by both departments to uphold the City's business licensing standards and public safety.

APPROVED COMPLIANCE LICENSING PROGRAM

The City of Victorville will be focusing on inspecting 82 businesses for compliance checks, promoting community well-being and reducing access to harmful substances. Victorville addressed sales enforcement with ordinance No. 2450 on June 18th, 2024, requiring annual inspections and banning flavored tobacco. Supported by a 4-0 City Council vote, it mandates compliance with standards for lighting, signage, health & safety and business & professions measures. All retailers, including pre-2015 ones, require on-site inspections to obtain a required tobacco retailers license and renewal of their City business license.
