Senate Bill 854 signed into law on June 20, 2014, became effective immediately. It established a new public works Proposer registration program which will collect fees to fund compliance monitoring and enforcement, determine prevailing wage and public works coverage, and hear enforcement appeals.

All Proposers and sub Proposers intending to bid or perform work on public works projects will be required to register, and annually renew, online for the program. This is a Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) fee paid to the State of California. The District will not register a Proposer/sub Proposer, nor collect funds for registration.

Starting July 1, 2017 the new annual registration fees for public works Proposers have increased to \$400.00, and Proposers on small projects are exempt from public works registration and electronic certified payroll reporting requirements.

Sub Proposer Eligibility. Proposer acknowledges that under Public Contract Code Section 6109 no Proposer or sub Proposer who is ineligible to bid or work on, or be awarded, a public works project under Labor Code Section 1777.1 or 1777.7 may bid on, be awarded, or perform work as a sub Proposer on, a public works project. Proposer is prohibited from performing work on a public works project with a sub Proposer who is ineligible to perform work on the public works project under Labor Code Section 1777.1 or 1777.7

Small Project Exemption:

Proposers who work exclusively on small public work projects are not required to register as a public works or file electronic certified payroll reports for those projects. Proposers are still required to maintain certified payroll records on a continuous basis, and provide them to the Labor Commissioner's Office upon request.

The small project exemption applies for public works projects that do not exceed:

- \$25,000 new construction, alteration, installation, demolition, or repair
- \$15,000 for maintenance

You may be asked to provide information needed to complete the DIR form. You will be asked to complete this in a timely manner to avoid interruption in the services you are providing.

Senate Bill 854 signed into law on June 20, 2014, became effective immediately. It established a new public works Proposer registration program which will collect fees to fund compliance monitoring and enforcement, determine prevailing wage and public works coverage, and hear enforcement appeals.

All Proposers and sub Proposers intending to bid or perform work on public works projects will be required to register, and annually renew, online for the program. Senate Bill 854 signed into law on June 20, 2014, became effective immediately. It established a new public works Proposer registration program which will collect fees to fund compliance monitoring and enforcement, determine prevailing wage and public works coverage, and hear enforcement appeals.

Senate Bill 854 signed into law on June 20, 2014, became effective immediately. It established a new public works Proposer registration program which will collect fees to fund compliance monitoring and enforcement, determine prevailing wage and public works coverage, and hear enforcement appeals.

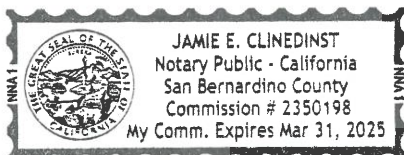

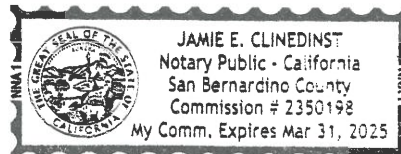

Senate Bill 854 signed into law on June 20, 2014, became effective immediately. It established a new public works Proposer registration program which will collect fees to fund compliance monitoring and enforcement, determine prevailing wage and public works coverage, and hear enforcement appeals.

All Proposers and sub Proposers intending to bid or perform work on public works projects will be required to register, and annually renew, online for the program. This is a Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) fee paid to the State of California. The District will not register a Proposer/sub Proposer, nor collect funds for registration.





### **Services Methodology**

Through many years of experience dealing with emergency on call projects, TK Construction is well adept at handling the chaos associated with emergency repairs. Our supervisors are trained to gather as much information in as little time possible while maintaining a forward momentum. They are provided with company trucks that are equipped with general repair tools, repair material and damage assessment tools. This provides them with an advantage to reduce response time thus reducing downtime of vital systems and ultimately minimizing the negative effects to the district's customers.

Throughout the repair process we enforce strict communication standards which will:

- a. Keep the District informed as to arrival times.
- b. Keep the District abreast of repair progress.
- c. Eliminate chaos and allow orderly actions to control.
- d. Keep crew members informed of potential safety hazards and present dangers.
- e. Help determine proper advance warnings to public and vehicular traffic.

Our goals during an emergency call are:

- a. Gather as much information as possible.
- b. Get on site to assess damage, determine equipment, and crew needs, establish control.
- c. Secure area; traffic control, communications, public safety, etc.
- d. Mobilize crew: labor, equipment, material.
- e. Execute repair with the highest level of safety, quality, and speed.

### **Emergency Services, Response times, and Response Crew Experience.**

Our procedure for responding to an emergency call is as follows:

1. Receive call.
2. Gather all applicable information regarding the emergency.
3. Establish chain of communication.
4. Verify underground service alert responsibility.
5. Gather material and pertinent specialized tools.
6. Mobilize equipment and crew.
7. Execute Repair.
