RESOLUTION NO. 23-054

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTORVILLE, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-24 TO BE FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of the City of Victorville (“City”) are aware of the projects proposed for funding in the City and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project’s completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City, will receive an estimated \$ 3,375,820 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2023-24 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the seventh year in which the City is receiving SB 1 funding, which will enable the City to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the City has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community’s transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the City used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the City’s priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the City maintain and rehabilitate roads throughout the City this year and similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City streets and roads are in an at-risk condition and this revenue will help the City increase the overall quality of its road system and over the next decade and bring City streets and roads into a “good” condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in the City's local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits Statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VICTORVILLE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the recitals set forth above are true and correct and are hereby incorporated in their entirety by this reference.

Section 2. That there are no newly proposed projects to be funded in-part or solely with Fiscal Year 2023-24 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues.

Section 3. That the following previously proposed and adopted project may also utilize Fiscal Year 2023-24 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in its delivery. With the relisting of this project in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the City is reaffirming to the public and the State its intent to fund this project with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

Project Title: Mojave Drive Street Improvements

Project Description: The project will rehabilitate and reconstruct the structural section of approximately 1.9 miles of Mojave Drive. In addition, non-standard ADA curb ramps and drive approaches will be removed and replaced.

Project Location: On Mojave Drive from El Evado Road to La Paz Drive

Estimated Project Schedule: Construction contract to be awarded by June 2024 and construction to be completed by February 2025.

Estimated Project Useful Life: 30 years

Section 4. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately as of the date of adoption.

Section 5. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution; shall enter the same in the book of original Resolutions of the City; and shall make a minute of passage and adoption thereof in the records of the proceedings of the City Council, in the minutes of the meeting at which this Resolution is passed and adopted.
