2022 Conflict of Interest Code

**Recommendation:**

That the City Council, sitting as the code reviewing body for the City of Victorville, the Southern California Logistics Airport Authority, the Southern California Logistics Rail Authority, the Victorville Library Board of Trustees, the Victorville Water District, the Successor Agency to the Victorville Redevelopment Agency, and the Victorville Joint Powers Financing Authority, adopt Resolution No. 22-100 amending the City's Conflict of Interest Code to update position classification titles, disclosure categories, and filing requirements for all agencies.

**Fiscal Impact:**

No fiscal impact is associated with this item.

**Discussion:**

Pursuant to Government Code Section 87000 *et seq.*, the Political Reform Act requires every local government agency review its Conflict of Interest Code biennially to determine if amendments or modifications are needed. The City's last such review occurred in December 2020.

Appendix 2 to the Conflict of Interest Code designates those employees, officers, and consultants who make or participate in the making of decisions for the City and/or its affiliated agencies which might affect their financial interests and specifies the categories of financial interests (as defined in Appendix 2a) each must include in their financial disclosure statements (Form 700s). These employees, officers, and consultants must also disqualify themselves from making or participating in the making of governmental decisions affecting those interests as set forth in Appendix 1.

Staff has reviewed the Conflict of Interest Codes for the City of Victorville, the Southern California Logistics Airport Authority, the Southern California Logistics Rail Authority, the Victorville Library Board of Trustees, the Successor Agency to the Victorville Redevelopment Agency, the Victorville Joint Powers Financing Authority, and the Victorville Water District and is recommending that Appendix 2 of the Code be amended to reflect any new or changed position classification titles since the last review, and to update the respective filing categories. The most recent version of Fair Political Practices Commission Regulation 18730 is also being incorporated as Appendix 1. Other than certain minor revisions necessary to harmonize the updated appendices with **Exhibit A**, no other changes to the Conflict of Interest Code are recommended at this time.
