Subject:

Notice of Completion – Green Tree Boulevard Extension

Recommendation:

That the Honorable City Council accept as complete and approve the Notice of Completion for Green Tree Boulevard Extension Project and authorize the City Manager to execute the Notice of Completion.

Fiscal Impact:

There is no fiscal impact associated with this item. Retention in the amount of five percent was withheld from each pay estimate during construction. Retention will be released after City Council approval and the recordation of the Notice of Completion. The retention account number, account description, and amount withheld are shown in the table below:

Strategic Plan Goal:

This project aligns with Goal E in the Strategic Plan, “Invest in Infrastructure” by providing road and bridge improvements that improved accessibility and mobility across the Burlington Northern Railroad tracks.

Background:

On March 16, 2021, the City Council awarded a construction contract to Skanska USA Civil West California District, Inc., in the amount of \$33,691,380.00. The contract was

awarded for infrastructure improvements which included the construction of the Green Tree Boulevard bridge over the Burlington Northern Railroad tracks and Santa Fe Wash. The work further included the construction of Green Tree Boulevard from Hesperia Road to Yates Road in the County of San Bernardino, two signalized intersections at Hesperia Road and Ridgecrest Road, water line and storm drain systems.

Discussion:

The project was completed at a final contract price of \$33,357,152.06, approximately 1% below the original contract amount. The final inspection occurred on June 13, 2023, when the project was substantially completed. The one-year warranty on the improvements began the date the work was accepted as substantially complete. Per California Public Contract Code § 7107(c), within 60 days after the recordation of the Notice of Completion, the City can release the final retention monies withheld on this project, provided there are no claims or unreleased liens against the contract.

Staff recommends that the City Council accept as complete and approve the Notice of Completion for Green Tree Boulevard Extension Project and authorize the City Manager to execute the Notice of Completion.
